

## Introductory letter for guardians/parents of new pupils



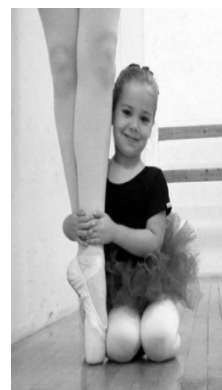
We would like to thank you for choosing our dance school and welcome you Pauleen's Dance Studio. Below is a list of guidelines we would like you to follow:

**Notice Board:** It is very important that you check the notice board regularly and also your email inbox. These are means of ongoing communication between teachers, pupils and guardians.

**The Annual Christmas Show:** will take place on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2017 @ 4.00pm at the Junior College Auditorium. This year's theme is 'Opposites'. Planning and preparations are well underway already.



- **Participants** are expected to pay for their costume.
- Attend the full Dress Rehearsal on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> December, starting @ 9.00am.
- Attend added rehearsals on set dates, of approximately two weeks prior to the Show date. Failing this, participants would not be allowed to take part in the Show, even though they would have paid for their costume.
- **Ticket prices are:**

**Adults – 15 Euros    Children (10 and under) – 10 Euros**  
**Participants do not pay for their ticket.**

- DVDs are to be pre-paid on order. Price 14 Euros each. No copying is allowed.

**BTDA Examinations:** Will be held on 23, 24 and 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018. Pupils will be examined by a foreign examiner, who comes purposely from British Theatre Dance Association in U.K. Fees will be placed on board at least 3 months before booking for exams.



**School Show-case:** To be held at the end of the scholastic year in June/July 2018. All pupils from the Pre-prep onwards are expected to participate. BTDA Certificates and Certificates of Participation will be awarded on the day. More information will be on the Notice Board as we near the event.
